



FIBRES WEST Scholarship for Fibres West 2019

The Fibres West Scholarship Fund was established in 2008. The Fund is used to assist a Fibres West participant who, without the benefit of the scholarship, would have difficulty attending the 2019 Fibres West event.

The Fibres West 2019 Scholarship will enable the successful recipient to attend the Fibres West residential week from 7 - 13 July 2019, at Muresk Institute. The Scholarship will cover 80% of the full-fee registration cost with the recipient contributing 20% of the full-fee registration cost. The recipient will also be responsible for any materials fees charged for their chosen workshop.

Criteria for Selection

- The applicant is a resident of Western Australia who, without the benefit of the scholarship, would be unlikely to be able to attend Fibres West 2019;
- The applicant is an active participant in the fibre arts community in Western Australia, either as a practitioner, someone involved with community groups, or a promising student.
- The recipient would be one whose participation at Fibres West 2019 will offer benefit to themselves and also the wider textile community, in some form.

Selection Procedure

A panel drawn from Fibres West 2019 organisers and others with a broad knowledge of the fibre/textile field, will review all applications and select a recipient. The selection panel's decision will be final and no discussion will be entered into. In the event that no suitable candidate is presented, the scholarship will not be awarded for Fibres West 2019 and the funds will be carried forward.

Nomination

An individual or a group representative must nominate the applicant. If the nominee is a tertiary student, their lecturer or tutor must nominate them.

Scholarship Application

There are two pages to the scholarship application form – **Part One** is to be completed by the person nominating the applicant and **Part Two** is to be completed by the applicant.

All applicants are requested to send a completed scholarship application to Fibres West TOGETHER WITH a Fibres West 2019 enrolment form AND \$200 deposit (unless already sent, please indicate if this is the case). **NOTE: If you are considering applying for the Fibres West 2019 scholarship we recommend that you enrol and pay your deposit as soon as possible after the programme is launched in July 2018 as classes fill quickly and we cannot guarantee you a place with your preferred tutor.** If your scholarship application is unsuccessful your deposit may be refunded – see below.

Unsuccessful applicants will have their deposit refunded if, as a direct result of not being awarded a Scholarship, they are unable to attend Fibres West 2019. The successful applicant's \$200 will be retained by Fibres West towards the recipient's required contribution (see above).
